William Dotson Dies at 62 Helped Make A. A. Success

AKRON, Ohio, Sept. 19 (AP)—Unable to talk. After a funeral service will be held Tuesday for attorney William Dotson, sixty-two, whose recovery from alcoholism has been termed the turning point of Alcoholics Anonymous.

Mr. Dotson died Friday night at Crite Veterans Hospital in Cleveland. He had been in ill health since a heart attack in October.

Mr. Dotson was forty-three and apparently a hopeless alcoholic when the two founders of A. A. found him in Akron City Hospital so intoxicated he was
